magine being on RMS Titanic's maiden voyage on 14<sup>th</sup> April 1912. Up until 11.40 pm, everything was perfect, and the passengers were enjoying another evening of wining, dining and dancing in the warm ambiance of the panelled ballroom. But then there were three dull thuds against the hull. Less than three hours later their cocooned world had been turned upside down by a lump of ice, and of the 2,224 people aboard, only 711 survived.

Imagine what it must have felt like standing on the deck as it began to slope more and more quickly, and you could see the dark water getting closer.

Now imagine how Elijah felt when he heard Jezebel, the wife of King Ahab, declare that she would surely have him killed in vengeance for the death of the prophets of Baal. Imagine what you would do in the circumstances. We read in 1 Kings 19 verse 3 that 'Elijah was afraid and fled for his life'. Arguably he stood a better chance of escape than the passengers on the Titanic, although they were not to know that even if all the lifeboats had been filled to capacity there would have only been room for about half of them. Elijah chose to stick to dry land and set off on a 40 day trek to Sinai. He was so convinced that he would die that he prayed for it to happen right away. However, God had other plans for him. In his misery, Elijah could have totally ignored God, but instead he listened to the still small voice assuring him that all would be well for him.

Next time things are looking hopeless in our lives, let's remember that nothing can separate us from the love of God.
