The picture of Jesus being tempted is an amazing reminder of his dual humanity and divinity. Here is God Almighty, in the person of Jesus, facing just the same sort of issues that you and I face every day. What does that say to us about how important we all are to him? Why would such a God want to spend any of his precious time with lowly creatures in his enormous creation, unless they were so important to him that he was willing to give so much of himself, even to be rejected and executed by people of his own creation, unless they were terribly important to him. So, imagine, here I am in Lent, with a devil on my back, but whistling a confident song about dancing in the morning (thank you Sydney Carter), because, however successful my devil may think he is, I know that Jesus Christ is my victory. He loves me too much to leave me to the tender ministrations of the Wormwoods and Screwtapes.
