

magine this - West End Smoothies on a night out! You can picture the scene. Bright London lights - young kids everywhere, done up in their gaudy best. Imagine our trepidation as we step down the alley towards the house door! Is this going to be like any other night club? The eager faced attendants hand us tonight's programme as we squeeze through the entrance. I squint at it as we enter the auditorium - the thud of rock music envelops me. Just like any other night club the dazzling white sofas are dotted around for the punters to sink into. For those who prefer to squat on the ground there are handy cushions to perch upon. Glowing disco lights lead the way.

Gradually the place starts to bounce and early arrivals are knocking back virtual tennis balls into the massive Wii screen above the stage area. We sip on a smoothie or two and find a suitable spot to perch where we won't be too obtrusive on account of our age, some forty years older than most of our companions tonight. A rat-at-tat-tat on the snare and the thud of the bass bring tonight's proceedings to a rousing start. The opener pounds in our ears - 'Oh Lord my God, when I in awesome wonder..'

No this isn't just another night club but a place called HTB (Holy Trinity Brompton) in West London. After three or four blazing numbers, a worship leader calls on the congregation to participate: "Those on the left you can get praying; those on the right keep on singing - then on verse two we'll swap over!" We are not sure how this works but it seems novel.

Nicky Gumbel comes on and does a hard sell for gift day. We are all invited to sign standing order forms and bring them down to the altar. The music and the raving get louder and more enthusiastic.

You can imagine some of our colleagues from Bishop's Stortford are less than impressed by Nicky's theology (conservative evangelical I think it is called). I think "Well it brings in the young people. They must be doing something right!" Imagine it - light years away conceptually from Chapel Hill's way of worship!

New Directions in Worship

From the time that our new church was formed in 2006 we have been varying our style of morning worship on the first Sunday in the month. On the same Sundays we also held afternoon worship in a more traditional style. Since the beginning of this year we have discontinued the afternoon service so that all our Sunday services are now at 10.30am.

We are continuing with our monthly informal worship, called New Directions. These services will be led sometimes by the Worship Team (Alan Wheeler, Mike & Marion Dyer plus others from time to time) and sometimes by one of our ministers or local prachers, which means they will not always be on the first Sunday in the month. Although the style is informal, no-one is 'put on the spot' or asked to contribute unless they wish to do so, and so we hope you will join us.

David's Sabbatical

David starts his sabbatical on Thursday 14th May, and completes it on Wednesday 26th August. He will be away for some of this time including a family holiday. Part of what he wants to do is to progress his DMin course including the initial stages of a research project he will be undertaking later. Obviously Allen Morton will be your minister at Stansted, and, as part of a LEP, will be able to deal with any Methodist issues except those which need to be done by the superintendent, which I will be covering.

We all hope that this sabbatical will be a great opportunity for David to recharge his spiritual batteries and feel refreshed and renewed on his return.


