


magine your feelings the day your crops have ripened and are ready to harvest. You are on your way to reap the corn, but first you have to seek permission from the soldier between you and your field. Maybe he'll let you have access today, maybe he won't. Imagine you are in your final year at university. You need to get to the campus to take your exam. Will you get permission to gain access? Maybe today, maybe not; everything lies in the hands of the soldier who can let you through or not.

This could be you if you are unfortunate enough to live in the West Bank. An 810 kilometre wall is in the final stages of construction and has carved out 46% of your people's territory. "Look how it doesn't even follow the Green Line from the 1949 armistice but garners big chunks of territory for Israel. When I used to visit Mum it was a journey of ten minutes. Can you imagine - it now takes two hours!"

Even though the International Court of Justice in the Hague declared it illegal, that seems to count for nothing. November 9th marks the day the Berlin Wall fell in 1989. Many people are going to mark that day to show solidarity with the Palestinian people. Activists the world over will be involved in anti-wall events. Spare a prayer for the people who suffer as a result of this barbarism. If you see a petition, remember to sign it. Imagine if these two peoples were able to live in peace and harmony, helping each other to achieve true Shalom/Salaam by respecting each other and building a common wealth in that fraught land that they share!
