

magine you are not yourself, but the person you are talking to / walking with / writing to ... I was lent a book for 'light holiday reading' called 'The man who forgot his wife'. When I had taken on the humour, anger, and strong language (as predicted in the blurb), I found a remarkable lesson in **understanding**. As the husband goes to the court for the final divorce hearing he recalls his wife's last furious outburst: "You never see things from *my* point of view!" (and so comes a life change for both). The man received the Wisdom of Solomon, who saw a mother's torment in her child's cry. He saw his really-loved wife in the pain she was feeling. As Job (28:12) pondered, 'Where can wisdom be found? And where is the place of understanding?'

Was it this **understanding** that brought Ian Paisley, scourge of the Roman Catholic Church, to change his "No! No! No! to popery" to "Enough! Enough! fellow-Irish killing"; and then come with Martin McGuiness to an amazing unity on policy and action for the preservation of Northern Ireland's peace - a firm friendship formed, by each coming to understand the other?

I was recovering from a slight accident when my young neighbour arrived, bearing a clip-board and a carton. "...the eggs you ordered...don't pay, but could you help me with my questionnaire on your faith?! - Do you believe in God? How did you first learn of Him? How do you see God? I replied along the lines of "As a loving Father; like when your father heard me when I fell last year and came and picked me up – just like that!" He was a God-send. I often wondered as a child what older people were thinking, and now I try to see what children see in this 'oldie'. I pray that through my unprepared, garbled answers to her quiz my young friend saw, behind me, just a little faith to go on.
