The picture was taken at Sycamore Gap in Hadrian's Wall by Owen Humphreys (reproduced Courtesy of Guardian News & Media Ltd).

It shows a bare tree silhouetted against the green, yellow and red light of the Aurora.

At Easter the cross is bare (the cross is sometimes described as the tree), although in some churches, including ours, it is decorated with spring flowers.

It is certainly empty. All the pain and suffering of Good Friday is past. God has met all the sin and evil of the world with the love of Christ. The victory of life over death has been won. And in the light of our Easter faith, we have re-born hope for ourselves and for the world. We see beyond the darkness of the cross to the glory of the resurrection. It causes us to shout alleluia (praise God) and to grasp hold of life with new determination to live by the light of faith.
