

magine what it must have been like for Joseph and Mary making the arduous hundred mile journey from Nazareth to Jerusalem each year to celebrate the Passover Festival. No doubt they would have recalled the momentous time when they made the even longer journey to Bethlehem. Then imagine what it must have been like taking their twelve-year old son with them. I am sure Jesus would have been just as impatient to get to their destination as children are today. You can imagine him repeatedly asking "Are we nearly there?".

When the week of celebration was ended, everyone set out to return home. However, on the occasion recorded by Luke (2: 41-51), things didn't go according to plan. Imagine how Joseph and Mary must have felt, when after a day's travel they discovered that their son was not with them. We probably cannot imagine how a child could not be missed for that long, but in those days it would be quite normal for all the children to travel in a group in the care of trusted adults. This would allow parents to have quality time together with the presumption that the children were being safely cared for.

We should not be too quick to criticise Joseph and Mary; can we honestly claim to have Jesus at the forefront of our thinking on every step of life's journey? Are we prepared to turn around and search for Jesus, or do we just hope he will catch up with us sometime? Imagine the joy when Joseph and Mary found their son back in Jerusalem. As we start our journey through a new year, let us testify to the joy that comes from knowing that Jesus is with us every step of the way.
