

magine what it must be like living in a tent. It is one thing to go 'glamping' when the weather is dry and warm, but no fun when it is wet and cold. There are thousands of refugees who have to make do with such conditions. Imagine you have also been separated from other family members and do not know where they are, or even whether they are still alive. What do people in that situation have to look forward to? The theme of our next Messy Church on 22nd January is 'hope', and we shall be exploring how hope provides a positive way of dealing with difficult circumstances.

Hope is a key foundation of the Christian gospel. With God on our side nothing is hopeless. When Joseph and Mary arrived in Bethlehem, the prospect of finding shelter was not looking good. However, the young couple trusted God's promise made through Gabriel. They hoped that all would be as foretold, and it was. When Noah was in the ark surrounded by floods, he hoped that the food supply would last out until the water subsided. God kept his promise and Noah was saved along with all his passengers.

At the beginning of a new year it is traditional to make resolutions. They may be made in good faith, and we may hope to keep to them, but research indicates that less than 20% will stay the course. Perhaps that is because we lack confidence in our own ability. Imagine how Noah must have felt having responsibility for his family and all those animals in the ark. The writer of the letter to the Hebrews provides some guidance on the relationship between hope and faith. He (or perhaps she?) writes: Faith makes us sure of what we hope for (Heb 11:1). So by being faithful to God we can be confident that our hopefulness will be rewarded.

Thanks be to God that this applies to everyone, including tentdwellers, stable-dwellers, ark-dwellers and ourselves. *Mike Dyer*
