

magine the wide-eyed bewilderment of the apostles on that first Easter morning! Their Lord and teacher had been cruelly executed three days before and his body buried in a rock tomb. Now the tomb was empty and some women among Jesus' followers had come running with the unbelievable truth that he was alive again!

The Unbelievable Truth is the title of a panel game on BBC Radio 4 hosted by comedian David Mitchell. Each week four guests take turns to deliver a brief monologue on a given subject. Concealed among the many inaccuracies and lies are five true statements which the guests must identify in order to win points.

Imagine you are listening to a monologue entitled Good News. You hear that Almighty God was born as a human baby; water was turned into wine at a wedding party; a travelling preacher gave sight to blind people and forgave sins; so the religious leaders had him put to death on a Roman cross; and on the third day after being buried he was seen alive again! Which of those statements would you believe to be true?

I imagine Doubting Thomas is not alone in struggling to believe the *Unbelievable Truth of the Resurrection*; but the truth is, there are signs of resurrection all around us, especially in Springtime. Seeds buried in the ground burst into new life; bare branches are clad in fresh leaves and blossom, and birds prepare their nests. Wounds are healed, grief is eased, divisions are reconciled and despair is turned to hope. As a former URC Moderator put it: "Creative God, you turn the shadow of death into the brightness of a new morning."

Christ is Alive! He is Risen! This is The Unbelievable Truth!


