

magine your house fell down. What would you do? Well, you might give thanks that no one was hurt. Then think about where you might find shelter; perhaps with a friend? But all your friends' houses have fallen down as well, because they have been hit by the same hurricane. Imagine that eighteen months later you are living in a 2m x 2m block of concrete about the size of a four-man tent, which used to be a communal shower. There are no windows or door, and the only furniture you have is a single bed.

Imagine you are bringing up three teenage daughters on your own in these conditions. Imagine you can't provide for your family as you used to, because your farmland was also destroyed.

This is the reality for Marcelin in Haiti, where Hurricane Matthew struck in 2016. Imagine that every day you live in fear of another storm. Imagine you could help Marcelin and his family to prepare for the next storm, so that they fear it less. The good news is that you can! Christian Aid can help Marcelin build a storm-resistant house, as they have done for many other families in Haiti.

On Saturday 12th May 10 am - noon at the Big Brekkie, together with the other churches in Stansted, we will be raising funds for Christian Aid's life-changing work in Haiti and in other countries. If you can't make that date, there will be envelopes in the church during Christian Aid Week, 13th-19th May. If you are a tax payer please gift-aid your donation. This year Christian Aid Week falls within Thy Kingdom Come, an ecumenical global prayer movement between Ascension Day and Pentecost. This is the Kingdom Prayer:

Holy God, in your Kingdom the strong need the weak, the rich are transformed by the poor, the fortunate are welcomed by the homeless. Your Kingdom is built by those who expect their God to come. Amen.
