

Imagine the darkest moment in your life. What did it feel like for you? All of us have some dark places we have experienced or carry within us. I know I do. Can we imagine them too?

The Christian journey takes us this month ever closer to Easter Day on Sunday 21st. Before we get to Easter Sunday, we have to embrace Good Friday. As some of the Gospel writers tell the story of Jesus' death on the cross, the last hours of Jesus' life are accompanied by darkness. Jesus is being portrayed as experiencing with us the shadowy side of our lives. Can we imagine Jesus being with us in that darkness?

Where is the meaning in Jesus experience of the darkness with us? The 15th century mystic known as Julian of Norwich is perhaps one of the most helpful guides for us. Around the age of 30, she was very ill and even expected to die. She was visited by a priest, who offered her a crucifix to hold. In that moment, she had a revelation of the love of God being present with her. Fortunately for us, she survived her illness and was able to record her revelation of Divine love. She went on to have further revelations of that love. Can we, in our darkest moments and places, imagine the crucified Christ with us bringing the love of God to us?

And then can we imagine the wonder and the joy of Easter Day, when we realise that there is nothing that can overcome the love of God?

May the presence and the joy of the crucified and risen Christ be with you all.
