This Christian Aid Week, the need for more trained midwives like Judith and better health facilities in Sierra Leone, where every day ten women die in childbirth, is being highlighted.

Imagine Tenneh's joy this time as she cradles a healthy baby in her arms.

Please give generously in Christian Aid week, 12th -16th May, so that other mums in Sierra Leone and around the world can see their babies grow and enjoy fullness of life.

Nurse Judith says "I know that for women here, thanks to Christian Aid, our situation is going to change".

Our congregation doubled in size one Sunday morning when we were joined by a group of 17 young people and seven adults from a large lively church in Hono, a small Swedish island to the west of Gothenburg. They were on a one-night stopover in Stansted.



Roy led the service which included Holy Communion.

Their leader had made contact via our website to let us know they were coming, which gave us time to prepare a bi-lingual order of service, thanks to *Google Translate!* 





One of the Swedish leaders, Anton, read part of St Luke's gospel in Swedish, which was followed by Judy reading the same passage in English. After the service, the group had their own session in the church, followed by a light lunch and short walk to some of the 'sights' of Stansted - namely the Windmill and the Recreation Ground! At 3.00pm we waved farewell at the station, where they boarded the train back to the airport for their flight.





Their church is part of the Equmeniakyrkan (Uniting Church in Sweden), formed in 2011 by the joining of the Mission Covenant Church of Sweden, the Baptist Union of Sweden and the United Methodist Church of Sweden.



As part of their preparation for Confirmation, the group were on their way to Gran Canaria to join a Swedish Christian sailing boat called *Flida*.

Their Confirmation service is on Sunday 12th May at 11 am (10 am our time).

We all had a wonderful day and are keeping in touch.
